### 4. M40 J12 - Road Scheme Update

Traffic management continues at J12, despite a projected end date of 'midend Summer 2016.' It was noted that on Sept 30<sup>th</sup> temporary lights were in use. The chair was asked to email Balfour Beatty for clarification on a final date for works and traffic management.

#### Balfour Beatty:

The project has completed and the traffic management that is in place is to complete a few low key items on behalf of our client. I have been advised that there should be no more traffic management updates from the end of next week (w/c 05/12).

#### WCC Update

The main scheme was finished back in July but there are some defects to correct and we are looking at the impacts of the changes that have been made to the JLR entrance. Some further improvements are being considered.

## 5. Site Developments Update

#### 5.1 British Motor Museum

JC New BMM Collections Centre building won a national building design award. RICs selected the building as the Midlands region Best Tourism and Leisure Building at a recent national finals.

Recent events included hosting of The Dunlop Image Collection and a World War One commemoration event for local school children. A model railway show on Saturday attracted 4500.

The recent infrastructure improvements have transformed traffic flows on the network, with no queues reported at the weekend. Improvements are working for BMM. Coped well with large numbers coming in and different patterns.

### .5.2 Jaguar Land Rover

### Gaydon Triangle

NF Planning fully approved. Company working with approved contractor, with hoardings to go up at the end of October.

Work to begin from middle to end of Nov.

CD Noise Vibration Harshness Centre (NVH)

Talks with principle contractor progressing.

### CD Kingsway Entrance

Widening of entrance under way with completion planned for January. It is hoped that it will help with B4100.

#### **Ecology Surveys**

JLR were asked about survey work taking place.

LH Confirmed that surveys are taking place in ecology area. These include infiltration and nutrient tests, archaeology checks, bunds-drainage and landscaping ecology.

#### Temporary Buildings.

NF A number of temporary consents have been sought. These include 548, 549 546 and the catering building 231.

#### 6. Parish Council Items

#### 6.1 Gaydon Parish Council

#### Leopold Application

Concerns raised about the impact of the site and it was asked if the site will be screened.

- LH Pegasus will look at it this but reiterated that it is a temporary feature.
- CD Confirmed it is purely there to support construction activities.

#### **Community Projects**

Engagement of JLR in community projects was discussed.

AW Explained that parishes can contact her to offer volunteer projects, but these are voluntary activities that take place usually within normal working hours.

# 6.2 Chesterton & Kingston

#### B4100

Query raised about whether JLR traffic models had been shared with WCC. It was confirmed that traffic survey data and models have been discussed and shared with WCC as part of the consultation for recent Planning submissions.

## Potential JLR/ AM traffic on old gated road

Following on from June survey where 185 potential JLR/AM vehicles were recorded, a similar more recent survey from September found just 14 such vehicles in a 1.5 hour period.

Situation much improved, village back to what it was pre-junction 12 construction start.
